- 1) The night before surgery, take your shower/bath and bathe area to be operated on **Hibiclens**. Follow the instructions on the bottle. This can be found over the counter at any drug store.
- 2) **NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT!!!**
- 3) STOP your Aspirin and Plavix 5 days prior to your procedure. STOP your Coumadin 2 days prior to your procedure. If you DO NOT do this, we will have to reschedule your surgery!!!! You will need to stop your Aspirin / Plavix / Coumadin / Pradaxa / Effient / Other: \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_.
- 4) You are having a surgical procedure. Therefore, you will more than likely experience some pain. This is normal. Everyone's pain tolerance is different. You will receive pain meds to relieve some of the pain, but do not expect to be pain free. Please refer to your discharge instructions for anything that seems out of the ordinary.
- 5) If there are biopsies during your procedure, it does take up to 7 business days for our office to receive the results. The office staff can NOT give results over the phone. The results will be given to you at your follow-up appointment by your doctor.

For outpatient procedures, a RESPONSIBLE family member or friend will need to take you to your procedure at the hospital, stay the ENTIRE time during the procedure, and drive you home afterwards! A taxicab or rural transport is NOT acceptable!

I have read the above instructions and understand that if I do not follow the above instructions; my procedure will have to be rescheduled.
